### 2021 - 2022 Fair Share Agreement

Dear Band and Color Guard Family:

In order to fund the extracurricular marching band program, we ask all of our families to help by contributing a "Fair Share" donation for the period. This amount is only for the annual fees associated with band expenses. This amount helps the students by funding expenses the school board will not cover such as materials for show props, show t-shirts, competition fees, transportation, any extra equipment needed, copyrights for the show music, the show drill, special instructor salaries, concert events and so forth. All of these budgeted expenses are totaled up and divided by the number of students we expect to have in the marching band program. Because we also hold other fundraisers, we are able to reduce Fair Share down from well over \$1000.00 per student (the actual cost from 2019-2020) to \$600.00 per student (the amount we are asking you to contribute out of pocket). The board understands that this is difficult for some families to come up with all at once, so we are offering payment plans for 2021 - 2022, beginning now. Payment plans have to start early since most of the band's expenses fall during the first 3 months of the school year. In addition to the out-of-pocket Fair Share obligation, we also ask that every student raise at least \$412.84 through our fundraising programs, based on an expected 67 participants.

Please note: Fair Share does NOT include the fee for the States field trip; we will not have an amount set for that trip until closer to the travel date as it depends on hotel and bus rates, food costs, ticket prices for the theme park we visit on the final day of the trip, how many students will be going, and so forth. Other items this will not cover include color guard uniform fees, marching shoes, winter guard, winter percussion, band jackets, the band banquet, etc.

### Please choose one of the following donation options:

Plan A: Lump sum: \$600.00 due September 9th\*

Plan B: 3 month payment plan: \$200.00 per month, due by end of August, September, and October Plan C: 8 month payment plan, \$75.00 per month, September through April (due on the first of the month)

\* If you can contribute the entire amount now this will benefit the band the most as we incur so many expenses prior to the start of the season!!
